Uniforms

- Fitting, repairing and solving uniform issues. Cutting and sewing uniform fronts.

Flags/Sewing

- Cutting and sewing flags, prepping flag poles (you don't need to know how to sew to help!)

Weekly Chaperones

- Bus chaperones for weekly competitions (take head count, monitor buses, address issues, etc.)
- May be required to help with getting the band on and off the field at competitions
- DOES NOT INCLUDE SEASON TRIP. MAY BE REQUIRED TO HELP WITH PIT CREW ACTIVITIES

Pit/Equipment

- Clean, paint, organize, repair and assist with anything that needs to be done
- For competitions, drive trucks (with district approval), load/unload trucks at school and competition site, setup props, bring equipment on and off field
- IMPORTANT: YOU WILL NOT SEE ANY OTHER BANDS (OR OUR BAND FROM ANY HIGHER THAN FIELD LEVEL)WHEN WORKING PIT CREW

Props

- Design/build/paint/purchase props for field show

Banquet (parents of seniors)

- Plan decorations, create program, setup the day of the banquet

Dome Day

- Plan decorations, organize volunteers, plan luncheon, track food donations, etc.

Dome Concessions

- Work the Carrier Dome concession stand during football/basketball games and special events
- Great fundraiser!!! Earn money for your students account for every person you bring to work

Starburst

- Our Home Show!! Parking, Concessions, Security, Tickets, Raffles, Setup/Teardown, etc.
- We need 125 volunteers to be successful so this is an "all hands on deck" event
